Controls

Make sure that users are aware the tower may fall,
Stand at an appropriate distance if tower is about to collapse
Have first aid box in case of any injuries.
Wear appropriate shoes.
Explorers to verbally monitor and warn users in case of collapse.

Have appropriate lighting for base.
Make sure explorers and scouts have torches if needed

Over Excited Behaviour

Controls

Make sure behaviour expectations are set out at the beginning.
Gentle reminders to bring users back onto task
Explorers to monitor, get a Leader if behaviour escalates.

Make sure clear instructions are given about Task.
Explorers to monitor for discomfort or injury.
Adult leader on hand for first aid if needed.
